## What NOT to Flush!

Recently, underwear and a plastic bag were found in a sewer pipe that cost \$1,500.00 to remove. Expenses like this are unnecessary and are completely avoidable.

Owners are reminded that only human waste and toilet paper can be flushed. Items like sanitary napkins and diapers (plus unwanted underwear) must be thrown in the trash. Plastic bags can be taken to your local grocery store for recycling.

Remember that money used to pay for these repairs is yours.



## Preparing for Winter

If you are shutting down your property for the winter and would like your **water turned off**, please contact David at manager@lakemcgregorresort.com or text 403-485-8105. The more notice he receives, the better, but a minimum of two days notice is required to ensure he is available.

The **outdoor swimming pool** is now closed. The **clubhouse** now closes at 9:00 p.m. If adults are still using the facility at this time, they can remain and staff will lock up when the building is empty.

The **northern most dock** cannot be used starting the week of September 23. This dock will be removed soon. The remaining dock will remain while weather permits, so owners can still fish, etc.

**Sewers** will be cleaned starting on September 25, and two **curb-stops** will be repaired. These repairs may effect road access for a day or two.
